ACADEMIC EXPECTATIONS

A Residential Learning Community should strive to consistently maintain a grade point average above the all-campus average. This helps convey the value-added quality in academic performance by being a member of the learning community. Reflecting the above average academic standard of the RLC ideals, the minimum GPA for membership and recruitment in the chapter should be at least 2.75. This grade point average minimum should guide the Vice President of Recruitment, Chaplain, and Standards Board when considering chapter membership issues and good standing.
